Intensive English Program

For students who want to improve their English for personal or academic purposes. Curriculum approved by Languages Canada (Age: 16+). Length: 1-52 weeks. Weekly intake

Junior / Senior High School Preparation Program

Develop the language skills, social skills, critical thinking skills, cultural knowledge and confidence to succeed in high school - then transition to the Prince Edward Island International Student Program.



University Preparation Program

Improve the skills for advanced academic challenges including research, critical thinking, presentations and debate. Upon successful completion students may enter directly in College or University (IELTS score of 7+ or a TOEFL iBT score of 94+ required).
