



## Background

- SACLI is accredited by Languages Canada, Canada's premier language organization representing over 130 study locations across the country. Languages Canada promotes quality English and French language training in Canada via internationally recognized standard setting and monitoring practices. As an accredited institution, SACLI meets or exceeds the high quality standards as set forth by Languages Canada. Quality standards cover all areas of program and service delivery and daily business operations including curriculum development, teacher qualifications, student services, student admissions, marketing, promotion, facilities management, and administration.
- SACLI is a member of TESL Canada, a national federation of English as a Second Language (ESL) teachers, learners and learner advocates. SACLI's teacher training program is TESL Canada certified.

## SACLI Program Offerings

*Intensive English Program (IEP):* Program is for students who wish to improve their English for personal or career purposes.

*Bridging Program:* Program is for students who wish to improve their English academic skills prior to entering college or university.

*International High School Program:* Program is for students wishing to improve their English academic skills through enrolment in public high school in Grade 10, 11 and/or 12.

*Study Tour Program:* This program combines morning classes, focused on communication, with afternoon activities, focused on Canadian and Prince Edward Island cultural experiences.

*Junior Vacation/Summer Camp Program:* This program offers youth the opportunity to experience summer fun in Prince Edward Island. The program includes ESL classes in the morning and a variety of afternoon activities.

*Parent/Child Program:* This program is for families wishing to participate in joint English training programs. Although children participate in the Junior Vacation Program and parents participate in the Intensive English Program, they come together one afternoon a week to take part in activities highlighting Canadian and Prince Edward Island culture.

*Private Classes:* Private classes provide one-on-one tutoring in a variety of subject areas including school content (Grade 1-12) and ESL (i.e. listening and speaking, pronunciation, grammar, reading, and writing).

*Teacher Training Program:* This program is for individuals wishing to become ESL teachers. The program requires participation in a 100-hour theory course and 20-hour practicum.

*Distance Learning Program:* This program offers live/face-to-face English language instruction via the Internet or telephone. Students can attend classes that are flexible and that fit their own personal schedule.

*Group Program:* This program is customized based on the wants and needs of the group. Program can be customized for small and large groups alike.

*Themed Study Tour Program:* This program is customized based on the wants and needs of the group. Program can be customized for small and large groups alike.

*Anne of Green Gables Program:* Program explores the works of Anne of Green Gables following the novel written by Lucy Maud Montgomery. Afternoons are spent experiencing “Anne” related activities.
