

## FAQ's

### How to register at SACLI:

- Choose the appropriate program of study at SACLI, read and understand SACLI policies
  - Complete application form and send with required deposit
  - SACLI will send you a Letter of Acceptance and all necessary documents to obtain a study permit (if necessary)
  - Apply for a Study permit (if necessary)
  - Send travel details to SACLI
  - SACLI will send a homestay description 30 days before the start of the program
  - Remit full payment 30 days before start of program
  - SACLI homestay family will meet you at airport
  - Attend SACLI welcome, orientation and language assessment first day of class!
- **How will I get to SACLI the first day of school?**

Your homestay family will drive you to school the first day - and every day - while you are studying at SACLI. Please go to this link: [Google Maps](#) for detailed information about our location.

- **What will I need to do on my first day of school?**

You should arrive at the school by 8:30 AM and report to the main office. You will participate in an orientation, take an assessment test, and enjoy a short tour of the school.

- **What do I need to bring my first day of school?**

Please bring your passport and proof of medical insurance. The office will make copies of each to place in your student file. If you do not have insurance when you arrive, you will need to buy it from SACLI, at a cost of \$12.50 per week. ([www.guardme.ca](http://www.guardme.ca))

- **What is the daily class schedule?**

Full-time students attend classes in the morning from 9:00 – 12:00 and in the afternoon from 1:00 – 3:30. SACLI offers free fun activities on Friday afternoons. Part-time students can study in the morning or afternoon (a minimum of four weeks duration required).

- **Where can I change my money?**

There are several banks across the road from SACLI at the Confederation Court Mall <http://confedcourtmall.com/>: TD Bank, Scotiabank, BMO, and CIBC.

- **Where can I buy a bus pass/bus tickets?**

Bus tickets can be purchased at the Shoppers Drug Mart at the Confederation Court Mall. The Charlottetown Bus route and schedule can be found at [www.thebus.ca](http://www.thebus.ca). You can also pay for tickets on the bus (exact change needed)

- **Can I use my laptop or mobile device at SACLI?**

SACLI has wireless internet throughout the school and a computer lab with computers capable of writing in many languages.

- **Do I get a student card?**

The first day of classes SACLI will take your picture and issue you a student card.
